SHOPS

The main shopping area in Jesmond is Acorn Road/ St George's Terrace (NE2 2DJ), off Osborne Road at the Waitrose/Café Nero junction. Here you can find **two chemists (Boots & Medicentre)**; **a Post Office**; two supermarkets; a hardware shop, a shoe repair shop; a bakery and cafés.

Other shops and cafés can be found at Brentwood Avenue (NE2 3DH); Jesmond Road/Cradlewell (NE2 1LB); and Clayton Road (NE2 4RB) where there is another Post Office. There is another supermarket near West Jesmond Metro station.
